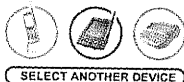

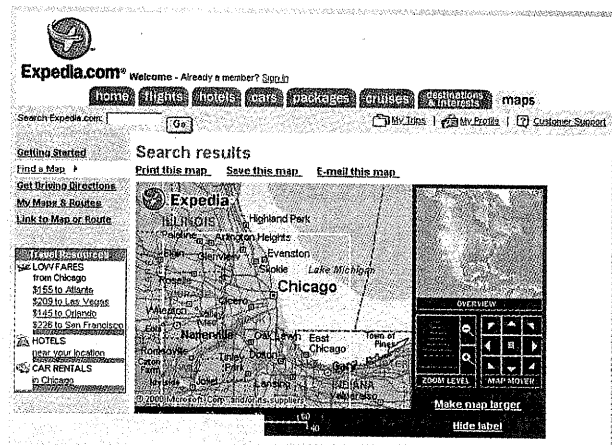

This site requires registration up front, but once in, you'll be treated to discounts on airfare and hotels. The site does allow you to browse select specials without registering, and you can also preview the search process. The company began in 1986 as America's Travel Store.

Slick, comprehensive, and quick, Expedia is one of the leading sites for reservations. Keep up on daily deals, name your price, check the weather, calculate currency conversions, browse for cruises, and read comments from other travelers about their trips on the community message boards.
